

# New restaurant opens atop Clark Tower

The Tower Room American Grille, a 175-seat restaurant, has opened on the 33rd floor atop the Clark Tower in East Memphis.

The a la carte restaurant is owned by the building's owner, In-Rel, and it is managed by Aramark, one of the largest food service companies in the U.S.

In addition to the restaurant, The Tower Room will offer extensive catering and an events facility on the east side of the 33rd floor. A lounge and several private dining rooms are located along the south side of the restaurant.

Lisa Ritenour, general manager of Clark Tower, says The Tower Room will target lunch customers from businesses in the heart of East Memphis as well as the 1,500 people who work in the building.

The restaurant is open for lunch Monday-Friday and dinner Tuesday-Saturday. Future plans include a Sunday brunch.

Ben Wilson will be the executive chef and general manager of the restaurant.

To appeal to a variety of tastes, the menu will include a large selection of items, including steaks, pork chops, chicken, seafood, pasta, sandwiches and entrée salads. The catering facility can handle groups up to 250.
